We operate on our core values of brotherhood, cheerfulness, service Everything we do amplifies those values in our members.

A Scout's troop takes priority. We limit the number of OA events and a Scout can attend as may or as few as they like.



Inductions Process The Challenges

- 1. A night alone (Preferably camping outside in your back yard)
- 2. Maintain a vow of silence (no talking)
- 3. Scant food (but not scant water)
- 4. Service to community

The OA does not in any way condone hazing. Make sure siblings in particular respect this.



Parent Responsibilities

Parent Responsibilities for the Induction Process:

- 1. Ensure safety.
- 2. Ensure Scout logs into LodgeMaster to create an "ArrowID" for their Scout record. The youth will receive an email invitation to create an ArrowID.
- 3. Keep candidate on schedule.
- 4. Ensure scout attends Friday night ceremony in Class A uniform
- 5. Provide candidate with their breakfast and lunch.
- 6. Supervise service.
- 7. Distribute Spirit of the Arrow booklets at appropriate times.
- 8. Put OA sash on candidate at the conclusion of the event. Class A Uniform required.
- 9. For candidates 18 and over, YPT must be current.

Suggested Service Projects

Service must be for the community. *Safety is the top priority no matter what service project is chosen.* Service time should be at least 4 hours. Make sure candidate stays hydrated at all times. Maintain county health rules regarding mask-wearing and social distancing.

Suggested Projects

- Adopt a park or neighborhood Pick up trash, clear trails, clean graffiti, remove fire hazards (Lake Chabot, Lake Elizabeth, Lake Merced, Iron Horse Trail)
- Run errands for seniors (can be family members).
- A service project for your Church or local school.
- Service From Home Gather and donate used items to a shelter. Make an emergency preparedness kit. Clear out fire hazards.

Suggested Materials:

• Mask, work gloves, yard tools, eye protection, trash bags, sanitizer, cleaning supplies

Nothing in the Order shall be interpreted as interfering with any member's religious obligation."

- Siblings, especially those in Scouting, should be not allowed to view ceremonies.
- Parents in Scouting may want to defer viewing ceremonies until they join the Order.
- All electronic communication devices should be powered down during the ceremony.
- Recording of video conferencing sessions is not permitted.
